Types of Scholarships

- International
 - Performance-based scholarships for students attending IUPUI from other countries.
- Nonresident
 - Performance-based scholarships for students attending IUPUI from other states.
- Incoming Students
 - Performance-based scholarships for new students.
 - Some of these scholarships are automatic awards while others require an application.
- Continuing Students
 - Scholarships for students who already attend IUPUI.
 - Requires an application (if scholarship is need based, a FASFA application must also be filled out).
- Private Sector
 - Scholarships from private sources other than the government or your school.

Tips for Applying

- Read over all requirements when applying.
- Make sure to read all directions carefully.
- Be sure to type your application and essay unless stated otherwise.
- Proofread all work prior to turning it in.
- If a fax is sent, follow up to make sure all the paperwork is received.
- If you are awarded the scholarship, be sure to thank the scholarship donors.
- Most importantly, be as professional as possible.
